Information we gather about your visit

A limited amount of information about your visit to RadiologyInfo.org is collected by the Radiological Society of North America (RSNA) and the American College of Radiology (ACR) for use in measuring the site's activity and to gather broad demographic information for the purpose of evaluating the effectiveness of the site.

- **Cookies**

A cookie is a small file that websites put on your computer, mobile device or tablet. We use cookies to collect anonymous statistics through Google Analytics. We also use cookies to allow us to remember selections that you make on the website during the course of your visit. None of these cookies contain personally identifiable information. Many browsers have settings that allow you to block cookies but be aware that if you block cookies in your browser it will apply to all websites that you visit using that browser. If you choose to block cookies, you will still be able to access all of the information posted on RadiologyInfo.org However, this may not be true for some other websites.
